Special Rules for TSATF Battles:

Troop Types by Nationality

British Naval Brigade Infantry: As British except Shoot as Egyptians.

Egyptian Sudanese Infantry: As British except Shoot as Egyptians.

Egyptian Arab Infantry: As Egyptians except Check Morale as Boer.

Bashi-Bazouks: As Boer* (including 30" Rifle Range) except Fight Close Combat as Colonials.

Bazingers: As Dervish Rifles.

* Note: Bashi-Bazouk Infantry can form a Square (but not Close Order Line) and can move 2D while in Square.

Machine Guns

1 Barrelled Gardner MG: Only 2D per Crewman and -1 to Hit.

2 Barrelled Gardner & Nordenfelt MGs: Only 2D per Crewman.

Maxim Style MGs: Reduced Jamming Risk – if 6 rolled then roll again needing 4-6 for actual jam to occur.

Artillery

Very Small Mountain or Light Guns (e.g. 3pdr): -1 to Hit.

Smoothbore Field Guns: Only 2D per Crewman.

Obsolete & Antique Guns: Only 2D per Crewman and -1 to Hit.
