## Special Rules for TSATF Battles:

### Troop Types by Nationality

*British Naval Brigade Infantry*: As British except <u>Shoot as Egyptians</u>. *Egyptian Sudanese Infantry*: As British except <u>Shoot as Egyptians</u>. *Egyptian Arab Infantry*: As Egyptians except <u>Check Morale as Boer</u>. *Bashi-Bazouks*: As Boer\* (including 30" Rifle Range) except <u>Fight Close Combat as Colonials</u>. *Bazingers*: As Dervish Rifles.

\* Note: Bashi-Bazouk Infantry can form a Square (but not Close Order Line) and can move 2D while in Square.

## Machine Guns

Barrelled Gardner MG: Only <u>2D per Crewman</u> and <u>-1 to Hit</u>.
 Barrelled Gardner & Nordenfelt MGs: Only <u>2D per Crewman</u>.
 Maxim Style MGs: Reduced Jamming Risk – if 6 rolled then <u>roll again needing 4-6</u> for actual jam to occur.

### <u>Artillery</u>

Very Small Mountain or Light Guns (e.g. 3pdr): <u>-1 to Hit</u>. Smoothbore Field Guns: Only <u>2D per Crewman</u>. Obsolete & Antique Guns: Only <u>2D per Crewman</u> and <u>-1 to Hit</u>.
