## NOTES:

- 1. Royal Canadian Dragoons (RCD) was the armoured battalion until 1987, when it was replaced by 8th Canadian Hussars. 3 RCR (replaced in the mid-1980s by 2PPCLI) and R22Re were the mech infantry battalions.
- 2. The M150 TOW in mech battalions were replaced by TUA (TOW II) in 1987.
- 3. During 1985-87 additional manning allowed 4CMBG to add a 4th rifle company in each mech battalion and two extra M109 stands (total six) to the artillery battalion. Prior to that the 4th infantry company was a mobilization unit.
